- 7. Optional: The award category under which you would like to be evaluated * Select ONE from the choices below:

Professionalism & Relational Competency: For demonstration of the values and integrity of professional psychology and/or relationships with a range of clients as they relate to the field of psychology

Science & Application Competency: For empirical demonstration, application, and evaluation of practices, interventions, and programs

Education & Systems Competency: For demonstration of learning strategies, educational accommodations, academic psychology and/or differing roles, worldviews professional standards, and contributions across contexts and systems.

Poster session applications must be received by the OPA office by February 5th, 2017.

Note: All poster session applications will be reviewed by the OPA conference committee. The primary applicant will be notified by April 7th, 2017 of their proposal status.
