OPA 2009 Student Research Award

The Oregon Psychological Association (OPA) is soliciting student papers to be considered for the 2009 OPA Student Research Award.

- The papers must report quantitative or qualitative research in psychology (critical literature reviews are acceptable).
- The papers must be written in APA style and be a ***maximum*** of 30 pages.
- Papers must be submitted via email to: Oregon Psychological Association, info@opa.org. All papers must also have a letter that states that you are applying for the student research award and your contact information.
- The deadline for student research award submissions is **Friday, March 6, 2009**.
- Papers will be evaluated by selected OPA Board Members.
- The student of the winning research paper will receive a one year complimentary student membership in OPA. The award will be presented sometime during the OPA Conference (exact date and time tbd).

OPA 2009 Conference Poster Session Presentations

- OPA will be holding a poster session during the Conference's continental breakfast and breaks on Saturday, May 9 at the Hilton Eugene Conference Center in Eugene, Oregon. If you are interested in applying for a poster session please submit the following information to the OPA office via email: name, title of poster session, brief description of poster session, and contact information. **Poster session applications must be received by the OPA office by March 6, 2009**. All poster session applications will be reviewed by the OPA conference committee chair and OPA will make the determination of which poster sessions will be used. All applicants will be notified by April 10 if they have been accepted or not. OPA will supply an easel for the poster session—all other materials including the poster board must be supplied by the presenter. We recommend that you use a sturdy board to display your materials on. Please note that space for poster sessions is limited. Applications must be sent via email to info@opa.org. If you wish to attend the conference, student registration is required.
